Include in the email your name, library card number, a good phone number to reach you, and a description of each photo. If you have titles for your photographs, include that in the message as well. Please submit photographs as JPEGs smaller than 15 MB.

Judging and Prizes:

Judges include city staff members involved in photography and Heritage House Partners. Prizes will be awarded for the top three photographs and will include:

- Ancestry DNA kit (\$99 value)
- Photograph will be on display at the Heritage House Museum in August and September
- A framed copy of the photograph after it is on display at the museum
